# PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Established in 1994, Ansvar's Community Education Program (CEP) provides grants to organisations that support the education, wellbeing and life skill development of disadvantaged young Australians.

Over the past 30 years, Ansvar has contributed more than **\$15 million** through the program, supporting over **300 charities and not-for-profit organisations** and helping to fund initiatives that have positively impacted thousands of young people across Australia.

The program offers funding under two categories:

- **Empowerment & Education** – supporting educational attainment, personal development and life skills.
- **Outreach & Support** – supporting programs that provide practical assistance, guidance and opportunities for young people facing disadvantage.

Through the CEP, Ansvar continues its long-standing commitment to strengthening communities and supporting organisations that create meaningful and lasting outcomes for Australian youth.

## IMPORTANT PROGRAM INFORMATION

When do grant applications open?	9am (AEST) Monday, 20 July 2026
When do grant applications close?	5pm (AEST) Friday, 28 August 2026
How much can my organisation apply for?	Up to \$50,000
When will I be notified of the outcome of my application and receive funding?	Applicants will be advised of the outcome of their application, and funds will be disbursed to successful applicants prior to the end of 2026.
Can previous CEP recipients apply for funding again?	Yes

## DOES MY ORGANISATION QUALIFY?

For a grant application to be considered it must meet all the below listed criteria:

- Applicant must be a not-for-profit organisation with DGR status.
- Grant request must not exceed \$50,000.
- Grant request must be for the purpose of funding a specific program.
- Program must target Australian youth under the age of 25 and fit into either of these categories;

**Empowerment and Education Programs** that provide opportunities to develop positive values that lead to healthy lifestyle choices and a positive contribution to our community.

**Outreach and Support Programs** that support youths who are at risk or are already experiencing difficulties (such as drug and/or alcohol abuse) through rehabilitation and/or skills training.

- Program must be intended to be sustainable beyond receiving a grant from Ansvar Insurance.

## WHAT IS A DEDUCTIBLE RECIPIENT (DGR) STATUS?

Organisations that are entitled to receive income tax-deductible gifts and tax-deductible contributions are called Deductible Gift Recipients (DGR). For further information on DGR status please visit the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission website or confirm your DGR status.

Please ensure you attach a copy of your organisations annual accounts when submitting your application form.

Any additional marketing materials that were not requested will not be assessed.

## WHAT ARE THE GRANT ASSESSMENT CRITERIA?

PROGRAM ATTRIBUTES?	FACTORS
Wide community benefit?	Size of Community benefit
Organisational Competency	Demonstrated competency based on application, credentials and prior history
Specific Outcomes	Specific outcomes are identified
Measurable Outcomes	Measurement practices are in place and reported on
Sustainability	Program becomes self-funding or with plans to be, following the completion of the grant program
Promotional and Volunteer Opportunities	Level of promotional and Ansvr Insurance staff involvement opportunities

## WHAT ARE THE GRANT OBLIGATIONS?

All successful grant recipients must comply with the following obligations, by not doing so future funding requests may be affected.

### GRANTS

Recipients must use the grant in accordance with the purpose and schedule agreed and not for any other purpose. Ansvr Insurance must be advised in writing of any proposed changes to how the grant will be spent.

### PROGRESS REPORTS

Recipients are required to submit progress reports. The first progress report is due 3 months into the program, the second is due 6 months into the program and the third is due 9 months into the program. Reports must detail any changes to the program or schedule which will have been agreed by Ansvr Insurance.

## Final Evaluation Report and Acquittal

Recipients are required to complete and submit a final report and acquittal form within thirty days of the completion of their program. Any outstanding reports may affect future grant requests.

## Promotion and Acknowledgment

Any marketing or promotional activities including published or display materials for the program must include Ansvar Insurance's logo and/or acknowledgment of grant support. Ansvar Insurance reserves the right to promote and detail the grant recipient's programs and grant details for its own marketing and reporting purposes.

## WHAT IS THE APPLICATION PROCESS?

3. Submit your online application by 5pm (AEST) Friday, 28 August 2026.

## CAN THE PROGRAM BE AUSPICED BY ANOTHER ORGANISATION?

Yes. Where an organisation is applying through an auspicing arrangement, full details must be provided within the application. This should include the name of the auspicing organisation, a description of the arrangement, and the respective roles and responsibilities of both the applicant and auspicing body. The application should clearly demonstrate how grant funds will be administered, who will be accountable for project delivery and reporting, and how governance and oversight of the project will be maintained. Supporting documentation confirming the auspicing arrangement may be requested.

## CAN WE SUBMIT MULTIPLE APPLICATIONS?

There is no limit to the number of applications an organisation may submit. However:

- Only one application per program is permitted, and
- Organisations will only receive funding for one program per funding round.
